

INTERNATIONAL (F1) STUDENT INITIAL I-20 ENROLLMENT GUIDE

Thank you for considering Indiana Wesleyan University! This guide is for students currently living in their home country wishing to join IWU as an F1 international student.

STEP 1. APPLY

- Submit your application indwes.edu/apply
- Submit all required documents for admission
 - $\circ \quad \textit{Complete admission requirements checklist in your application account} \\$
 - You can view admission requirements by selecting your program on the IWU website
 - The IWU enrollment team will contact you with questions, needed clarification, or additional document requirements



STEP 2. COLLECT YOUR INITIAL I-20

- Your admit letter is accessed in your application account
- Access your IWU Student Portal account
- Upon admission you will receive details regarding access to your IWU Terra Dotta account. This account will guide you through the process of submitting all required information for your I-20.
 - Terra Dotta access is emailed to your IWU student email



STEP 3. APPLY FOR VISA


- Pay your I-901 Fee via FMJfee.com
- Student currently in their home country
 - Complete DS-160
 - Schedule visa appointment
 - Attend visa interview
 - Notify IWU of your visa approval via ticket form
- Upon entry to the US, complete the Terra Dotta check-in process



STEP 4. FINANCIAL CLEARANCE

- Return to your application account for financial requirements
 - Form: Financial Policy Agreement
 - Form: Financial Responsibility Form
 - \$500 Deposit
 - Payment Plan set-up

Students must complete all 4 financial requirements for course registration Full instructions are available by clicking each checklist item



STEP 5. GET READY FOR CLASS!

- Access your IWU Student Portal at myiwu.indwes.edu
 - Check your student email for announcements and information
 - Access Brightspace to view and begin your 1st courses
- Attend a virtual orientation session
- Full student start guide is available on the F1 page in the student portal
